How Much a Tailor Earns in India?

Tailoring is a skilled trade, and the average tailor in India earns a decent wage. However, many factors can affect how much a tailor earns, such as experience, location, and type of work. The income also varies based on the time and month of the year. During Durga Puja in West Bengal, especially in Kolkata, few tailors get orders up to a value of a few lakhs. Those tailors outsource their orders to workers with lower wages.
